

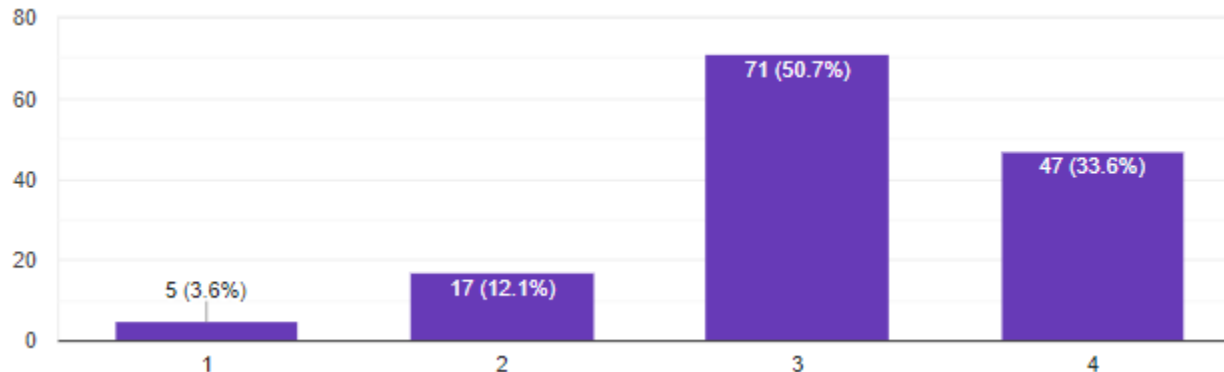
Evaluation “Language Sensitive Learning”

- March 2021
- Google Forms (adapted from an already existing survey)
- 139 responses
- 46,8% grade 5-6
- 52,5% grade 7-10



Positive Feedback

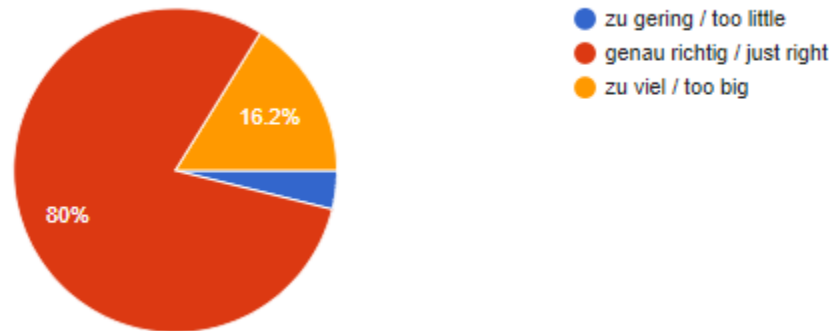
- The teacher speaks the language of instruction all the time. (97%) (btw: students only 69,1%)
- Mistakes the students make are corrected in an adequate way. (84,3%)





Positive Feedback

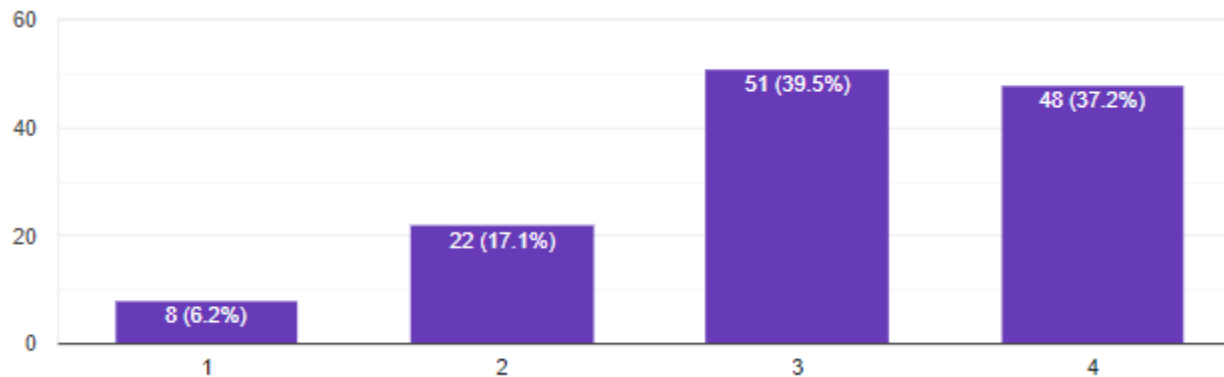
- The students understand the corrections and are able to correct the text themselves. (81,4%)
- The amount of new vocabulary is just right. (80%)





Positive Feedback

- The language is practiced in different ways (cloze texts, pictures, key words, ...). (76,7%)

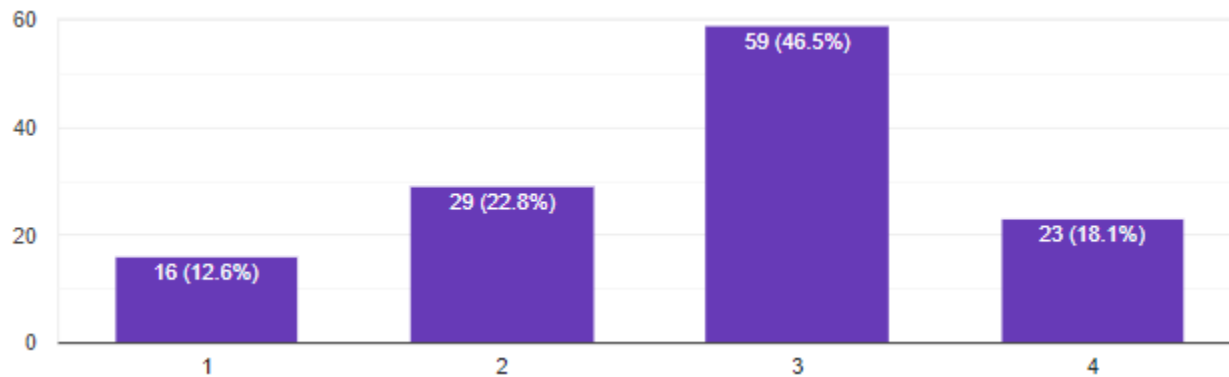


- New nouns are written down with the article and plural. (76,2%)



Less positive Feedback

- New verbs are introduced with all 3 forms. (64,6%)

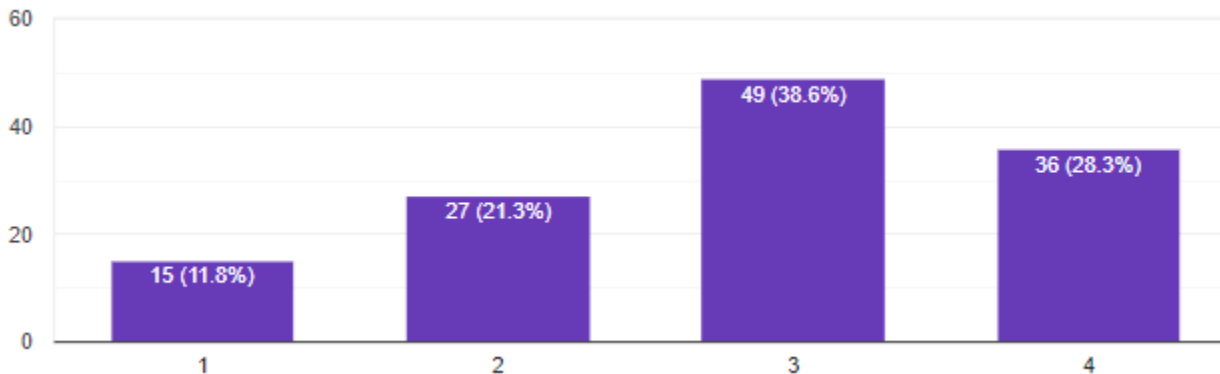


- New vocabulary is used or introduced with an example sentence. (70,8%)



Less positive Feedback

- The teacher advises the students to use dictionaries and other aids to write texts. (66,9%)



- Texts are corrected in red and green. (73,5%)



Essentials / recommendations

➤ Positive Feedback

- The students remind us to follow our guidelines (e.g. correction in red and green), but we should also remind the students to use the german language as their language of instruction.
